Water (Campsite near to the river)	All participants	Warn campers of proximity of river and brook.	Yes
Fire	All participants	 No open fires allowed. Campers warned that they must be aware of the fire risk of cooking equipment and the flammability of tents including proper procedures for refuelling. Campers are encouraged to bring their own fire blanket/fire extinguisher. The Club will provide a Fire Point with a tub of water/bucket. If used for cooking tents should be 5 metres apart. Food Poisoning	All participants	 Clean drinking water available from Pengwern Boat Club Campers responsible for making sure proper food hygiene principles are followed. 	Yes Yes
Waste	All participants	Waste food to be placed into bin sacks and disposed of in regatta waste bins.	Yes
Health (Personal hygiene)	All participants	Toilet facilities are available on the camping field. Washing facilities are available at the Pengwern Boat Club.	Yes
Extreme weather (cold, wind, heavy rain, heat & sun, electric storms, floods)	All participants	 Use adequate equipment/clothing/sun protection. In emergency participants can shelter undercover at Pengwern Boat Club. 	Yes Yes
General	All participants	 First aid available during the hours of racing at Pengwern Boat Club. Outside these hours emergency care available - Royal Shrewsbury Hospital, 5 minutes away. 	Yes
Child protection	Juniors & Members of the public	Where appropriate all proper child protection guidelines to be followed. Any issues to be reported to the regatta welfare officer.	Yes
